Garison Steele Safe Driving Elite Award was established in 2013 to honor the memory of Garison Steele, age 14, who graduated to heaven when he was a passenger in a car of a teen driver who lost control and crashed into a tree. Carry the Light, G&P Community Driving School and now, Garison Steele Safe Driving Elite Award were established to continue Garison Steele's legacy. The purpose of this award is a onetime annual gift scholarship that is distributed on or around December 7th of each year. The scholarship is open to Texas teenagers with learner permits or driver license who attended G & P Community Driving School with the same interest in promoting Teen Safe Driving. The goal of the award is to recognize the attitudes and behaviors that contribute to safe driving habits. Garison Steele Safe Driving Elite Award was founded to assist deserving students to aid their educational goals, meet their professional objectives and succeed to their fullest ability in their pursuit of higher education.

Criteria for the Garison Steele Safe Driving Elite Award is that students;

- 1. Must have a Texas Motor Vehicle Department License/Permit 15-18 years of age
- 2. Must have attended G & P Community Driving School.
- 3 . Must be recommended by 2 licensed drivers age 21 or older.
- 4. Must write an essay on why it is important to promote 'safe and responsible driving'.

Minimum requirement – applicant must submit an essay on 'Responsible Driving – Making the right choices'. First, tell us about yourself. What makes you a safe driver? How do you set a good example for your peers and younger family members? Please include your thoughts on any or all of the following:

- A. influences of others (friends, parents, etc) and G&P Community Driving School in your driving.
- B. choosing safety behind the wheel
- C. habits and skills while in the driver seat
- D. your personal experiences and examples

Your essay should be typed with 14 pt. font.

5. Recipient and family or friend must attend the award ceremony held in connection with the annual Carry the Light meeting with Joyful Sound Church held on or around December 7th Final date TBA Essay is due on Oct 1st unless other wise stated.

Students between the ages of 15-18 currently attending high school and have attended or attending at G & P Community Driving School.

Students between the ages of 15-18 currently attending high school and have their TX driver license/permit and attend Joyful Sound Church/Christian Academy
